2	COVID-19 Roundtable
	 No new challenges, MOL and IHSA (as MOL deputy) are continuing inspections, supply chain seems to be loosening up, workers seem comfortable as long as they have the right tools, distancing is normal, PPE supplies are easier to obtain. Problems with the public on some jobsites, some complaints received. Personal assessments every day using Survey monkey QR codes with link to daily questionnaire and website with MS form workers fill out. Workers forget to social distance at times or are not always able to distance depending on the nature of their work. People are becoming complacent. Offices are semi-open. Very hot too be wearing masks. Some are wetting bandanas, cool packs under hardhats and sunshades. Developed a form for dispatcher and have a field level risk assessment to make sure everyone is captured by dispatcher on one form. Some hand sanitizers have been recalled.
