

Capital Program Tendering Trends


- The average annual capital spending over the last five years has been over \$2B.
- The ministry consistently tenders a high volume of capital projects (major and minor capital), typically over 250 projects annually.
- The volume of work annually is subject to change and may decrease from projections early in the tendering cycle.
 - Tender changes may occur due to availability of funding, timing to obtain project and environmental approvals, property acquisition and construction requirements.
- Although we expect to tender less than we originally forecasted, we are on track to fully spend our budget this year.
 - We continually monitor in-year forecasts and adjust our program with the objective of fully spending our budget
- Proposed advertising of contracts are also impacted by financial impact of construction contracts already underway and MTO's spending authority limits
 - MTO began the year 2020-21 fiscal year with over 160 active MTO-delivered (non-P3) highway construction projects valued at \$3.5 billion – a significant amount of carryover work.
- Some projects underway are progressing faster than anticipated Contractors have been able to take advantage of lower traffic volumes to increase production.
- MTO has continued to deliver projects during COVID
- An additional \$15M was received from the Supporting People and Jobs Fund for additional projects in the South

Ontario's Highway Programs

- Provide a three year outlook on current and proposed capital construction projects across the province (northern and southern Ontario).
 - Current version 2020 to 2022
 - Includes Rehab and Expansion projects
- Updated annually as northern and southern Ontario Highways Program is updated – typically after March 31st of every year.
- Projects are subject to change based on availability of funding, anticipated schedule changes and timing based obtaining necessary approvals and permits.
- Outlook 2021 and beyond continued strong investment in critical rehabilitation and expansion projects throughout the province.
 - Variety of delivery models Design-Bid-Build (DBB), Design-Build (DB), Design-Bid-Finance (P3), CMGC etc.
 - Variety of contract sizes <\$5M to >\$100M
- Continue with key expansion projects Hwy 417, Hwy 17 Arnprior to Renfrew

Major Capital (Highway Program)

- 28 carryover projects
 - 3 Design Build projects
- Late 2019 tendering (2020 construction Advertised August December 2019
 - 4 projects
- Early Award Advertised January 1 March 31, 2020
 - 3 projects
- Projects Advertised April 1 October 31, 2020
 - 13 projects
- Anticipated tenders (November December 2020)
 - 5 projects planned
 - Includes paving, culverts, bridge rehabs

2020 Rehabilitation Program Highlights

Minor Capital

- Early Award Advertised January 1 March 31, 2020
 - 4 projects
- Projects Advertised April 1 October 31, 2020
 - 13 projects
- Typical Work
 - Selective resurfacing
 - Culvert repair/replacements
 - Advance tree clearing
 - Wildlife fencing
 - Facility improvements/repairs

Expansion Program Highlights

Highway 417 – Ottawa Queensway from Maitland Avenue to Island Park

Expected completion June 2021

Highway 17 – Arnprior to Renfrew – Status Update

- "Segment 1" new interchange at Renfrew Co Rd. 508 (Calabogie Road)
 - Design Build project
 - Procurement initiated late May 2020, RFP opening late November
 - Expected award early 2021, construction start fall 2021
- "Segment 2" 22.5 km widening from Scheel Drive, Arnprior to west of Bruce Street, Renfrew, three new interchanges
 - P3 delivery model
 - Currently undertaking P3/DB ready activities
 - Start date to be determined, pending completion of design, property acquisition and EA
