	 OPH has indicated that it cannot accommodate workplace-led vaccination clinics due to limited vaccine supply and capacity to be able to onboard and distribute vaccine for these proposed clinics. MOL is encouraging use of eye shields with face masks. An operator not wearing a mask was fined \$850. An operator received a notification from the COVID app and tested positive. MOL upgraded person to high risk. Three MOL site visits. No orders were issued. Cannot ask whether employees are vaccinated as is private health information however people don't want to work with unvaccinated people. Aecon took a blind survey. Some employees call in to say that they got vaccinated so that a donation to charity is made.
